Ground rules

- 1. The meeting is not a forum for individual complaints and single issues.
- 2. We advocate open and honest communication and challenge between individuals.
- 3. We will be flexible, listen, ask for help and support each other
- 4. We will demonstrate a commitment to delivering results as a group.
- 5. Silence indicates agreement speak up but always go through the Chair.
- 6. All views are valid and will be listened too.
- 7. No phone or other disruptions.
- 8. We will start and finish on time and stick to the agenda.
- 9. The group will comprise of no more than 12 members. Anyone wishing to join when the group is up to a maximum number will be asked to join virtual group until a member steps down.
- 10. Quorum will be 5 members plus a practice representative.
- 11. Should a member miss 3 meetings in a row the Patient Liaison Officer will enquire whether they wish to remain as a member?
- 12. The initial term served will be left open for members to continue if they wish too.
- 13. Chair to be a volunteer and elected by members where there is more than one candidate.
- 14. Secretary to be a practice member, Patient Liaison Officer.
- 15. Chair and secretary to be responsible for the Agenda. AOB items may be deferred on majority vote.
- 16. Additional rules to be added by consensus.
- 17. Chair has only a casting vote
- 18. Urgent AOB's may result in removal or amendment of the existing agenda.
- 19. PPG Members must not use their position in the group to influence the outcome of any personal requirements they may have with the practice.
